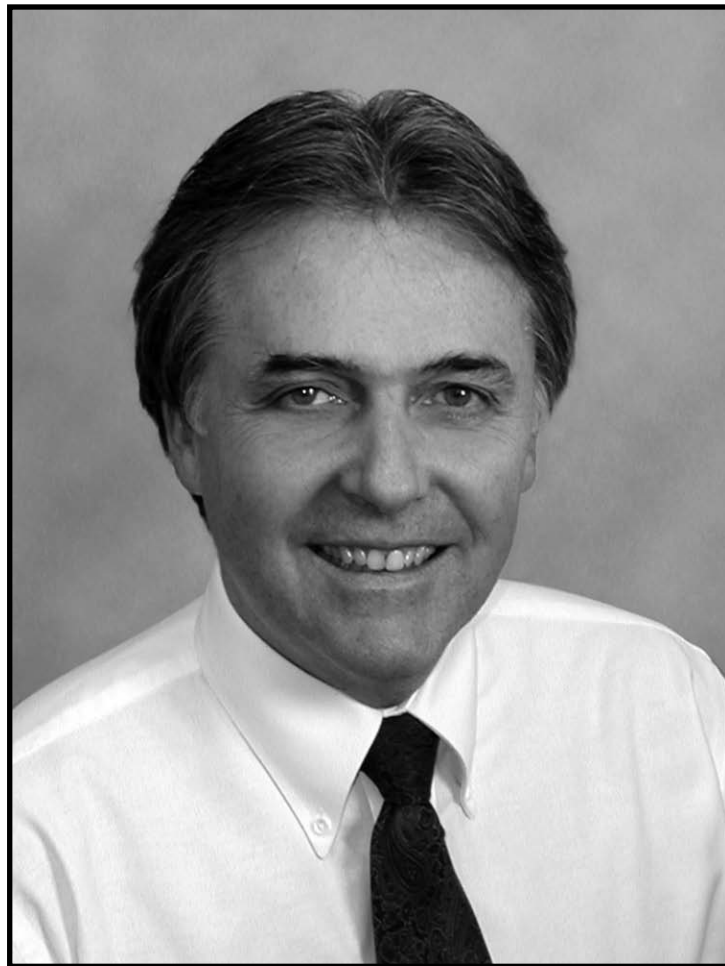

Legislative Committee Report

Saturday, December 9, 2006 marked the end of the 109th Congressional session. It was the culmination of a week that involved one of the greatest accomplishments and one of the greatest disappointments in the battle for passage of the Consumer Assurance of Radiologic Excellence Bill, HR 1426. 135 cosponsors had been identified in the House, along with 19 Senators. On December 6, the U.S. Senate **unanimously** passed the bill, now known in both chambers of Congress as the CARE bill. This signified that Congress has recognized the significance of the need for federal minimum standards of education and credentialing for medical imaging and radiation therapy according to Christine Lung, ASRT Director of Government Relations. E-mails were flying as constituents contacted their congressional representatives to support the bill when it came up for the anticipated vote in the House. Almost hourly updates came from Ms. Lung to ASRT Grass Roots committee members as they waited for the CARE bill to be brought to the floor. Congress worked until approximately 3 a.m. that Saturday morning, but the CARE Bill did not get the opportunity to be voted on. Congress adjourned for the year, and the bill died.

The ASRT had been proactive in anticipating a change in Congressional leadership with the November 2006 elections. A Democratic Congressional representative had already been briefed and earmarked as the next legislator to reintroduce the Bill. The ASRT's work paid off as on January 19, the CARE Bill was already reintroduced to the House by Representative Mike Doyle (D) of Pennsylvania. It has been given a bill number of HR 583 and a new name! CARE now stands for the **“Consistency, Accuracy, Responsibility, and Excellence in Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy”** bill. The content of the bill is the same CARE bill that was passed last year in the Senate. The ASRT is hoping for reintroduction of the bill to this Senate by the end of January! We are off to a great start! Fortunately, 123 representatives that were former cosponsors returned to their offices. 12 did not due to 8 retirements and 4 lost elections. 50 new members of Congress have been elected and will need to be apprised of the CARE bill message. This includes Representative Steve Kagen of District 8, formerly held by gubernatorial candidate Mark Green. Connie Geier and Sandra Helinski will return to the RT in DC program March 18-20 to meet with Wisconsin's federal legislators and ask for the continued co-sponsorship of Representatives Ryan, Baldwin, and Kind of Districts 1-3 respectively. The other representatives will again be asked to become cosponsors and reminded of the CARE legislation's importance.

On the state front, the change in leadership of many of the committees had temporarily slowed some of the momentum gained last year in our efforts for state licensure. November's elections changed the control of the State Senate to Democrats with an 18-15 margin. The Assembly retained its control by Republicans although by a narrower margin than last session. In meetings last year, Senator Carol Roessler (R) authorized the drafting of a bill as Chairperson of the Senate Committee on Health, Children, Families, Aging and Long Term Care. She can no longer serve as the Chair of this committee, although she would be a valuable ally. This committee is being split into two separate entities. Our lobbyist Mr. Blumenfeld has been keeping the pulse on the emerging committee leadership posts and has identified another potential leader for our bill. On December 1, 2006 a telephone conference was held with the drafting attorney with Mr. Blumenfeld, Connie Geier, Susan Sanson, and myself in lieu of an actual meeting due to the major snowstorm. Revisions were made to the draft, and it is currently under review. An actual draft will put us in good position to inform state legislators of our effort and ask for their sponsorship once meetings begin. It may even aid our federal efforts as well. There is a lot of work yet to be done on both fronts.

The committee urges everyone to keep the CARE legislation on their personal “radar screens.” As we saw last year on the federal level, there are no guarantees. However, we are in the best position ever since the beginning of this effort so **early** in this session of Congress. This has been the lowest bill number ever! I urge all members to check out the latest legislative letters that can be sent to your senators and representatives on the **www.WSRT.net** website. Please send them to the Wisconsin offices (not D.C offices) of your legislators, or e-mail your congressional representatives and senators. All of us should thank Senators Kohl and Feingold for their vote in favor of the CARE legislation last year with an e-mail or letter. With persistence our cause will prevail and our nation’s patients will be protected. Order and wear a CARE bracelet and spread the word!

Thank you and all WSRT members for your continued support. It is a pleasure and very exciting to serve our society in this role.

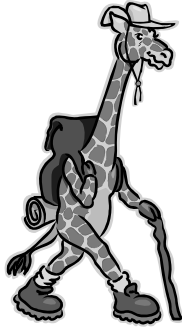

Come One, Come All to the WSRT Annual Conference, April 26th-28th at the Kalahari Conference Center in Wisconsin Dells.

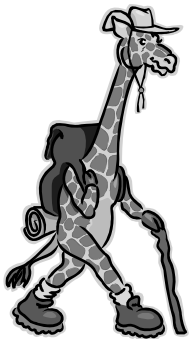
This year we will have a new tracking system for issuing credits that should make the whole process smoother.

It will have the name of the speaker, title of the presentation, and the date. It will also have a space for the speaker evaluation. At the end of the presentation you will be given the ASRT # to write on the card. You will then drop the card into a designated box on your way out of the room. After the conference you will each receive, through the mail, a list of the presentations that you attended which include the ASRT approval numbers. You should keep that list in your permanent records in case of an audit. We will also keep the cards on file in case of a question.

Entrance to a presentation will NOT be allowed more than 10 minutes after a speaker has started and the ASRT number will not be announced until the speaker has finished speaking and all questions are answered. Students will also have to follow the same entrance rules.

One note that may be important to those technologists who have historically used CPR toward CE credits. Starting Jan. 1, 2007, the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) will no longer accept completion of basic cardiopulmonary resuscitation for Category A CE credit. The ARRT considers basic CPR a job requirement for practicing radiologic technologists and does not consider it to be continuing education.

The ARRT will accept advanced cardiac life support, instructor or instructor trainer CPR for a maximum of six Category A CE credits, if approved by a Recognized Continuing Education Evaluation Mechanism or with a valid card from the American Red Cross, the American Heart Association or the American Health and Safety Institute.

I look forward to being more active in this role as the year progresses and am excited about the activity surrounding legislation at the state and federal levels.
