# Legislative Committee Report—Winter 2008

Sandra Helinski- Legislative Committee Chairperson

I would just like to update you on the status of our legislative efforts. I am proud to say that at the end of 2007, the WSRT has become noticed on the state legislative radar, and we are no longer a faceless entity. We have succeeded in obtaining another co-sponsor for the federal bill, Congressman Dr. Steve Kagen of Congressional District 8 due to our persistence. Wisconsin now has 4 of our 8 federal representatives as CARE Bill cosponsors.

As we all have been informed, LRB-2463/7 is the number given to the bill that has been circulated in the state legislature. Currently, a group of impressive co-sponsors has been gathered. This was a result of multiple visits to the legislators' offices by the committee members and the continual communications of Michael Blumenfeld with the legislators and their staff. We are in a good position to have this bill introduced in 2008. A hearing is anticipated early in the year.

As a result of a major effort carried out by the All Saints student body and staff, over 5700 letters were mailed out to all registered technologists in the state, in a joint and cost effective measure to inform them of the upcoming 2008 Annual Conference and legislative efforts. As a result, our committee has received some very positive and thankful e-mails regarding the progress of this effort. One technologist in a 715 area code praised the effort as in his opinion "this was really needed." He states that currently medical assistants with no x-ray background are taking films on patients at satellite offices, and his staff is required to hang those films for the radiologists to read. He states that in many cases, his staff is required to repeat those films as they are rejected by the radiologists. It was a call like this that confirmed our resolve. There were also a couple of angry e-mails that focused on the licensure fee. This woman stated to Sue and Connie in an e-mail that she is upset she has to pay for continuing education and that no one pays for her uniforms as well. A call I received focused on the LXMO provisions, citing problems in another state. Upon researching what this person stated, even though he claimed he was informed about the federal CARE bill provisions (LXMO's are included), and that state's laws, it was unfounded as that neighboring state, Minnesota has been successful in enacting a bill almost identical to our LRB 2463/7. Calls like that provide an opportunity for learning, and are catalysts for investigation. It is important to keep our "eye on the prize" as Connie has stated: *Proper protection for Wisconsin's patients.*

As we move forward into 2008, we anticipate movement on our bill, with a companion bill to be circulated soon in the state Senate. This is the same strategy used in the federal effort. It would be appreciated that all of you forward any comments to us on your feedback so we can address them prior to a hearing on the bill. It is important for us to realize that the secondary, yet extremely important result of the passage of the state legislation would be the establishment of the Radiography Examining Board. It is curious that the RT in DC brochure that just went out for the event in March does not entirely focus on the CARE bill. I believe that this may be due to the fact that there may be rapid movement on it in 2008, and if so, we need to have the

mechanism in our state to execute the mandates that it will place on Wisconsin. Who better to do that for the practice of radiography than radiographers? Right now, it could be *anyone* carrying out that duty. Keep this in mind—as of now, we **Radiologic Technologists have no state voice in our practice as we are not licensed. Even though we have created a stir and awareness in our legislature, the job is not done until we are professionals in the eyes of the state. Our bill would accomplish this.**

As Chairperson, I just want to thank the WSRT for allowing me, Connie Geier and Sue Sanson to represent the WSRT and work toward our goal. We need to commend Michael Blumenfeld on navigating us through the process, and the minefields so far. We could not have done this on our own. We have put a lot of time and effort in this, and there are no guarantees. Connie Geier and I will be representing Wisconsin and the WSRT on Capitol Hill in March at the RT in DC program. We will be visiting with all of Wisconsin's federal legislators to ask for their support of the CARE legislation. We will do the best we can to help Wisconsin's patients get the proper radiologic care they deserve on both the state and federal levels.

# ***NEW FROM WSRT***

## **CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP PROTOCOL**

1. All corporate renewals will be sent to the sponsoring institution 45 day prior to expiration as per the bylaws of the WSRT. Each corporation should designate a contact person to work with WSRT Member Services.
2. Corporate members are a minimum of six (6) individuals who are members (employees) of the same organization who are qualified to hold either an Active/ASRT or an Associate membership in the WSRT.
3. No other membership categories qualify for Corporate Membership.
4. The expiration date for members of a corporate group will be the end of the month the Membership Application is received.
