The Wisconsin Society of Radiologic Technologists (WSRT) is the professional organization of radiologic technologists in the state of Wisconsin. The WSRT represents approximately 7,000 registered radiologic professionals. The WSRT is in strong support of the licensure of radiologic technologists and issuance of permits to qualified limited x-ray machine operators (LXMO). Chapter 462 of Wisconsin State Statutes was enacted in 2010 to ensure that patients receive only safety-conscious, cost-effective, and quality diagnostic imaging throughout the state.

The Wisconsin Society of Radiologic Technologists is in support of the proposed update of the scope of radiologic practice standards, related to Chapters RAD 1 and 4 from the 2017 standards of practice adopted by the American Society of Radiologic Technologists (ASRT) to reflect those most recently adopted in 2019. Wisconsin's scope of practice standards for both the registered radiologic technologist and the limited x-ray machine operator are modeled according to the standards established by the ASRT, considered to be the gold standard in radiologic practices.
